- Do you have any stories of you or your relatives learning English? Learning Hebrew? Learning other languages? If your family converted to Judaism, do you have any stories of learning to speak Jewish English or to read Hebrew?
- What words did your grandparents, parents, or you use for Shabbat greeting, Passover seder, kosher, blessing, rabbi, synagogue? Were any of them pronounced differently from how you or I pronounce them?

What are all of the last names you know of in our family? Do you know what they mean and where they come from? (If not, you can look them up together in the <u>ANU database</u> to see if you can learn more.)

Do you know if anyone in our family changed their name? If so, tell me the story of why.
