


## Hope Holder

Thank you for being part of Jewish Futures 2025! We hope you'll use this tool to spark meaningful conversations, both today and beyond.





## **Assembly Instructions**

- 1) Cut out the large square.
- **2) Fold Diagonally:** With the pictures **face down**, fold the square paper in half to form a triangle. Open it back up and fold it diagonally the other way. When you unfold again, you'll have two creases that cross in the center.



3) Fold the Corners to the Center: With the square flat, take each corner of the paper and fold it to the center point where the two diagonal creases meet. You should now have a smaller square shape.



**4) Flip and Repeat:** Flip the paper over so the folded flaps are facing down. Again, fold each corner to the center point. You'll end up with an even smaller square.



**5) Create Creases for Opening:** Fold the smaller square in half horizontally, then unfold it. Then fold it in half vertically.





**6) Form the Pockets:** Gently lift the paper and slip your fingers under the four flaps (pockets). Pinch the sides together to form a 3D shape.



Your Hope Holder is ready!

## **Using the Hope Holder**

- 1) Find a partner!
- 2) One person starts by selecting a corner image or word. As you spell out that word, move the Hope Holder in and out. For instance, if your partner chooses the star image, you will move the Hope Holder four times while spelling "S-T-A-R."
- 3) The individual then picks a number, and you move the Hope Holder accordingly.
- 4) Select another number and open the flap to reveal the question or prompt underneath. Both partners share their responses.
- 5) Switch roles and play again!
