

Dreidel Game Instructions

How to Play

Each player starts with an equal amount of gelt, coins, or other game pieces.

Players begin by placing one piece in the center to create the "pot."

The youngest player spins first.

Depending on which Hebrew letter the dreidel lands on, players complete one of the following actions:

 Nun Do Nothing.	 Gimmel Take all!	 Hay Take half.	 Shin Put one in.

If the pot becomes empty, each player adds one piece.

If a player loses all of their game pieces, they are out.

The last remaining player wins that round.

The Hebrew Letters on the dreidel stand for the phrase "A Great Miracle Happened There."








