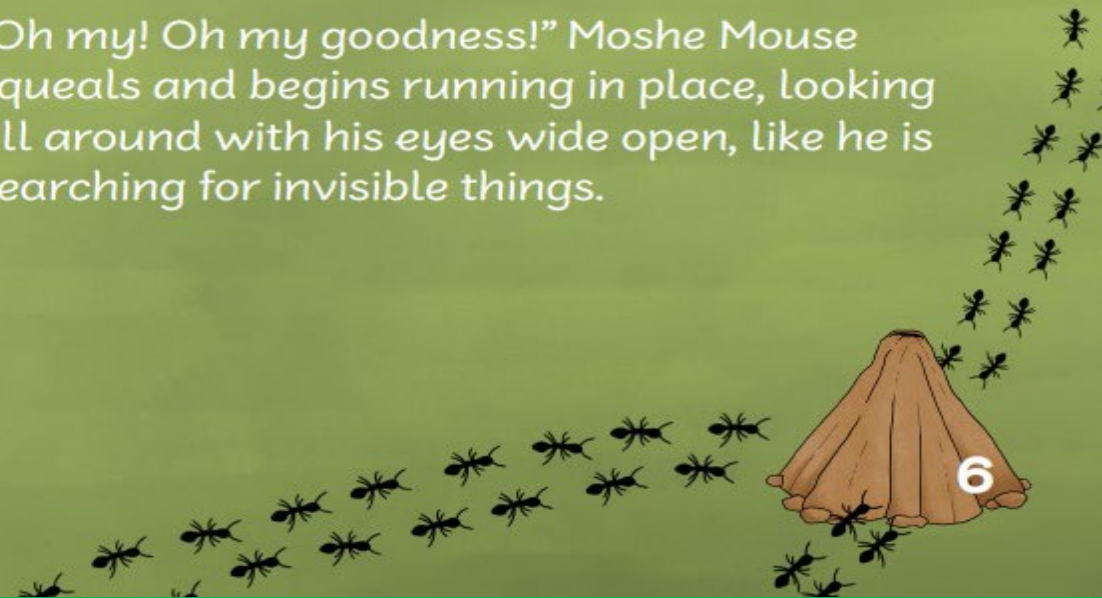
Later Alligator

We never talked about the third part of this saying." Leo was proud of himself for remembering it.

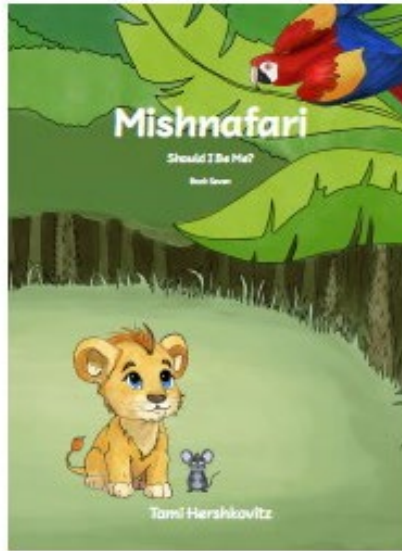
