Now more than ever, teens are asking about Israel. We can help you respond.

Participants in the Qushiyot Israel Education Fellowship will be empowered to develop and impart meaningful and relevant Israel education experiences for their teens. They will learn the open and comprehensive approach of the "Four Hatikvah Questions (4HQ)", created by Makom: The Jewish Agency for Israel Education Lab, which has been used in communities around the world, including Israel.

Our students are struggling to express themselves and respond to others with different, strongly held opinions. The pedagogic approaches that create safe spaces allow teens to engage in complex, respectful dialogue, cultivating a more nuanced relationship with Israel. These approaches can be applied to many components of our work as Jewish educators.

***Qushiyot:** the word originates in the Four Questions from Seder night, and the chevruta and study involved in answering them. Qushiyot are questions that stop you in your tracks, makes you dig further into an issue and demand a considered answer.









WHAT? The cohort of Qushiyot Long Island Educators of Teens will:

- Induct educators into a new, practical framework for structuring Israel education.
- Empower educators to develop contemporary Israel curricular modules.
- Address the complexity of Israel and examine personal relationships to Israel.
- Provide individual coaches to guide and support educators' work throughout the year.

WHO? Long Island based Jewish educators that:

- Work with students grades 7 12 in a congregation, JCC or similar part-time setting.
- Have current or future responsibility for teaching Israel at their institution.
- Have a desire to upgrade the Israel education at their institution.
- Feel inspired by the challenge of Israel education.
