### Scenarios Discussion

#### Introduction to Teachers and Parents

Each page of this packet presents a tzedakah challenge and choices for the learner on how to help. Use these scenarios to have a discussion with learners about the many ways a person can help another person. There is no correct choice for each scenario.

#### Preparation

Provide a copy of pages 2–5 of this packet to all learners.

#### For Discussion

Discuss how each choice might help the person in need. Why each choice is an important way to help. There is no correct choice for each scenario.

#### Introduction to Players

There are many ways to give tzedakah. What's important is that you give in a way that really helps the person. After listening to each tzedakah challenge, choose the way you would help.

#### Concluding Question for Players

How could you help?




Donate your used coat.

How could you help?




Ask your local store to donate to your school.
