We meet Noah, a righteous person, who is instructed by G-d to build the Ark. Noah takes his family and all the animals onto the Ark and the flood began, and it rained for 40 days and nights. The water covered the earth for 300 days, at the end of which the Ark rested upon Mount Ararat. After spending a full year in the Ark, Noah and his family leave the Ark and G-d promises that the world will never experience such destruction again, and uses a rainbow as the symbol of that promise. Then we are told about the Tower of Babel and how G-d intervened, causing all the people to speak different languages. The weekly portion ends with the introduction of Abram and Sarai.
