- 4. Proud Jews express their Jewish identities in both Jewish and non-Jewish spaces through their interactions and behaviors
- 5. Proud Jews integrate Jewish history, wisdom, values, and behaviors into everyday moments throughout their lives

6. Proud Jews see themselves as part of the collective story of the Jewish people
7. Proud Jews have a strong sense of commitment to the Jewish people
8. Proud Jews have intergenerational connections and relationships
9. Proud Jews are comfortable with dissonance because their Jewish understandings allow for nuance and difference of opinion
10. Proud Jews have a meaningful relationship with Israel
