**Take a look at the ketubot around the room and consider the following questions:**

- What do they have in common?
- What can the designs tell you about each ketubah?
- What time period do you think each is from? Why?
- What Jewish symbols can you identify that are incorporated in the design?
- What types of additional decorations are used? (animals, flowers, words, etc...)
- What language is the ketubah written in? Do you recognize any of the words?
- Focus on one ketubah and take a closer look at the details – what do you notice about the design, material and other elements?
- Try to imagine the wedding ceremony that took place, while this ketubah was being read. Who are the people present at the ceremony, how are they dressed, what language are they speaking?
- What surprises you about this ketubah?
- What questions do you have about this ketubah?
