

REGENTS - QUALITY CONTROL DO'S AND DON'TS

It is the school's responsibility to make sure that every answer sheet submitted for scanning has been first reviewed to make sure that:

- 1. The student's ID number is exactly as it appears in Level 0
- 2. Every question on Side 2 has one completed score bubble.

DO

- SHARE WITH YOUR STAFF GUIDELINES AND SAMPLES FOR QUALITY CONTROL.
 - These documents can also be found on our website.
- USE ONLY BLUE OR BLACK INK AS DIRECTED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE SHEET.
 - o Go over the bubbles if any other item was used (ex. pencil or red ink).
- CODE TEACHERS PROPERLY AS DIRECTED ON SIDE 2 OF THE SHEET.
- NEATLY WRITE WALK-IN STUDENT'S LEVEL 0 ID ON BOTH SIDES OF THE SHEET:
 - Side 1 In the box in the lower left.
 - Side 2 On the line in the upper right.
- COMPLETE ONE SCORE BUBBLE PER QUESTION ON SIDE 2 OF THE SHEET.
- ASSIGN A STAFF MEMBER TO REVIEW EACH SHEET PRIOR TO SHIPPING FOR SCANNING.

DO NOT

- DO NOT CROSS OUT ANY BAR CODES!
 - Student's pre-printed Level 0 ID in the box on Side 1 -
 - If the ID is incorrect, use a white mailing label and cover the entire bar code. Then, neatly write the student's correct Level 0 ID.
 - School's pre-printed ID (bar code in lower right of Side 1) -
 - If your student used a different school's answer sheet, <u>submit the sheet for scanning in a separate batch and note the name of the correct school</u>.
- DO NOT USE LIQUID WHITE OUT!
 - Follow the answer sheet's directions for correctly changing a choice of bubble.
 - For scoring total changes, neatly cross out the incorrect total and neatly write the correct total next to it.
- DO NOT USE A MARKER TO SCORE ANSWER SHEETS!
 - Markers bleed through to the other side and will be an issue when scanning.
- DO NOT SUBMIT AN ANSWER SHEET THAT, ON SIDE 2:
 - o Is missing even a single score bubble because scanning will indicate an error!
 - Has improperly completed score bubbles because scanning will indicate an error!
 - This refers to putting a small dot in the bubble or a scribble in the bubble.
 - Has multiple completed score bubbles for a single question because scanning will indicate an error!
 - This refers to completing more than one bubble for the same question.
